2. Ruddock Hall

The Ruddock Hall is a modern, state of the art multi-purpose performance space that caters acoustically for soloists, small orchestras, choirs and larger symphony orchestras. Its unique versatility shines through as it also transforms into an end on theatre space that lends itself to drama, dance and musical theatre.

2.1 Seating & Stage Configuration

Maximum capacity 503 (includes 12 standing spaces and using no stage extension)

Please discuss your requirements when booking in order to gauge the number of seats you require as there are extra costs for opening the balcony level.

2.2 Stage Extensions

The stage can be extended into the auditorium by removing seats and changing the floor level:

Extension 1: Row AA and Row BB are removed. Capacity is reduced by 43 seats

Extension 2: Row CC and row DD are removed. Capacity is reduced by a further 43 seats

Please note: the default configuration uses extension 1 and includes 4 upstage orchestral risers. If your event requires a different configuration please let us know when making your booking.

3. Studio Theatre

The Studio Theatre is a black box space that can cater for a variety of performance styles ranging from end on to thrust and round theatre style.

3.1 Seating & Stage Configuration

Maximum capacity 120

The seating is made up of benched seating on tiered staging, this is flexible and can be set in various configurations, please discuss regarding capacity for specific arrangements.

The standard set-up, consisting of four rows of seats with a centre aisle will seat 60.

3.2 Stage Equipment

The Studio Theatre has a black painted floor and black walls with a carpeted surface along the side under the balcony. Masking consists of a pair of legs hung in each upstage corner of the stage, a full width black on a track to mask the projector screen on the upstage wall, and black masking on a track mounted to the underside of the balcony to mask the SR walkway.

The Studio Theatre has a fixed grid with a maximum clearance between it and the stage floor of 5m, there are no moveable bars in the Studio Theatre.

There are two operating positions, the principle one is on the balcony with a second smaller one in the seating for rehearsals and production periods.

The two dressing rooms are fully accessible for artists with disabilities. They are both on the same level as The Ruddock Hall and Studio Theatre stages with shared accessible toilet and shower facilities. There is a lift to enable access to all levels of the Ruddock Performing Arts Centre.

5. DANCE STUDIO / REHEARSAL SPACE

Designed specifically for dance, the first floor studio space benefits from panoramic open views across Winterbourne Gardens and offers performers a unique open space with plenty of natural light. This makes it a perfect place for performance, rehearsals, conference, meetings and receptions.

Room dimensions: 9.25m x 9.75m, with an 8.5m x 2.1m full length mirror along one wall.

Reversible Black or Grey Dance floor is available on request.




